PURCHASES/IMPROVEMENTS

<u>January</u> - <u>Providence Farmer's Supply Company</u> store demolished. **Travis Stokes** (track hoe), **William Bull** (track hoe) and **Barry Hutto** (dump truck) provided machinery for this project. DHEC trailer, which tracked 23 gas monitoring wells on property for six years, was removed.

<u>June-July</u> - DHEC gave the property a clear report and two remaining underground tanks were removed at the time the asphalt was taken up. Topsoil was brought in and leveled.

July - William Bull and Andrew Bull (Wilshire Sod Farm) donated and planted sod on the lot.

Members of committee in charge of this work, **Johnny Hutto**, **Gayle Rush**, **Barry Hutto**, **David Shuler and Matt Stokes** worked tirelessly throughout all aspects of this project from contacting all stockholders in the *Supply Company*, dissolving the Corporation, getting appraisals, supervising the purchase of the property, asbestos inspection and removal, getting DHEC permits, and organizing the actual demolition of the building and leveling of the lot.
